



## Wharton County Cotton Defoliation Field Day

**When:** Monday, August 7, 2017 at 1:00 pm

**Where:** From the Colorado River on Business 59 in Wharton, travel south west on Business 59 for 1.3 Miles. Turn left onto CR 448, and immediately cross the railroad tracks. After the railroad tracks, turn right. Follow CR 448 for 1 mile. Turn left on CR 428. Go 8/10 of a mile and the defoliation plot will be on your left. See map on page 2.

The plot has both one-shot and follow-up treatments to compare to commonly used combinations and will give producers an idea of what to expect regarding leaf drop and opening of bolls. Dr. Gaylon Morgan, State Cotton Specialist, will be available to answer any questions.
