Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **ten (10)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **eight (8)** recoveries. The total number of fatalities remains at **forty-nine (49.)** Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **forty-four (44)**, that does NOT include any probables.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing will be TODAY, NOVEMBER 6, at the El Campo Civic Center, until 4 pm. We will also have testing next TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 10, at the Wharton Civic Center. No prior registration is necessary. The test is free.
